- Riders under 18 years must be accompanied by a responsible adult for the duration of the event.
- Hats to one of the following standards must be worn: PAS015 1998 or 2001, VG1 01.040 2014-12, provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC marked. ASTM F1163 2004a provided it is SEI marked. SNELL E2001 or E2016. AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards provided they are SAI global marked and correctly secured at all times when mounted. - All riders must wear suitable riding footwear. Wellington boots and trainers are not allowed.

Your Horse

- All horses must be over the age of four years and of appropriate fitness level for the activity being undertaken – hooves and shoes must be in good condition.
- Tack must be in safe condition and fit correctly.
- Don't forget it is a legal requirement to have your horses' passport when travelling to events.
