TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Ride is limited BHS Gold Members ONLY and numbers are limited.
2. Strictly no refunds, except if the event is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances.
3. As BHS Gold members you will be covered by Third Party Public Liability Insurance.
4. On arrival all vehicles should access the estate via the back entrance to Greyabbey Estate on the Ballywalter Road, please follow the signs and directions for car parking – please call at the Registration Point following parking.

Access to the back entrance is best approached from the Ballywalter direction due to a very tight turn into the gates.

5. **Starting times will be staggered and a time will be allocated on booking**
Sunday, 17 March – Ride out Times – 1pm, 2.30pm, 4pm Should be off-site by 6pm
Saturday, 27 April – Ride out Times – 11am, 12.30pm, 2pm, 3.30pm
Should be off-site by 5pm
6. Numbered tabards will be provided and must be worn. A £5 refundable deposit is required for each tabard.
7. This is a walk and trot ride only due to the terrain and No lead rein, walkers or dogs are allowed for Health and Safety reasons.
8. Riders must keep to designated trails and approved areas at all times. Do not ride on cut verges nor poach up the surface. Please leave gates as you find them.
9. It is advised that riders take a mobile phone. An emergency contact number will be displayed in the Registration point.
10. All riders must report their return to the Registration point.
11. All horses and ponies must be no younger than 4 years of age.
12. Riders aged 14 and under must be accompanied on the ride by a responsible and suitably experienced adult.
13. The ride takes place in the Greyabbey Estate. Riders are requested to respect this private estate and must follow all direction signs and markers. Please respect the Estate and take all litter and droppings home.
14. Good riding manners are requested. Please note the tabard number of anyone causing difficulty to others and inform the stewards on the route or at the Registration point.
15. Horses should not be left unattended in the parking area or on the ride.
16. **NOTE: Riding hats will be checked and tagged at registration.** A correctly fitted and secured hat must be worn when mounted, leading or loading horses. Hats must carry one of the following current hat standards, PAS 015 (1998 or 2011), AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards), ASTM F1163, VG1 01.040 (2014-12), or Snell E2001 and should carry a BSi 'KITE' mark or the American equivalent, the 'SEI' mark. All hats should carry a 'CE' mark.

Riders who present with an out of date riding hat will not be allowed to ride.
