**Entries:** There is no limit on the number of individual and/or team entries a riding club can have.

**Entries must be made via the E-Riders website only, the individual or a parent/guardian will need to setup their own account on E-Riders and make their own entries.**

**Teams:** To be part of a team each member must purchase the 'Team Converter' option for £1 in addition to their individual entry. (Please see team composition info below)

**Refunds are via E-Riders, please refer to their website for the refund policy.**

**Results:** Will be published on Facebook and the E-Riders website on **Friday 31 July** Scoresheets will be available to download from the E-Riders website at this time.

**Team Composition:** To be made up of **4 different riders**, riding any combination of tests (including bitless bridle class). **Clubs may have multiple teams and there is no restriction on how many teams a rider can be in for the club, if they are using a different entry for each team.**

All riders in a team need to be members of the same club, as the team is representing their riding club.

Scores will be calculated using the percentage from each test added together. All four scores to count. Entries converted into a team entry are still counted as an individual for that test.

**Rosettes:** Rosettes will be awarded to the top 10 teams and individuals in each section.

**Classes & Eligibility:** It is the responsibility of the rider to ensure they are eligible.

**Classes will be split into sections if entries are sufficient to do so.**

<b>1: Under 10's Intro</b> Lead rein optional	E-Riders Intro 1b (2020)	Riders must be under 10 years old on the entry open date: <b>08/05/2026</b>
<b>2: Junior Intro</b>	E-Riders Intro 1b (2020)	Riders must be junior BRC members. Horses can have up to 35 BD Prelim points, 0 points at Novice level or above. Horses cannot have competed at Novice level or above BD or BRC in the last 12 months.
<b>3: Junior Prelim</b>	E-Riders Prelim 2b (2020)	Riders must be junior BRC members. Horses can have unlimited Prelim Points, up to 35 Novice Points, 0 points at Elementary or above. Horses cannot have competed in Elementary or above BD or BRC in the last 12 months.
<b>4: Senior Intro</b>	E-Riders Intro 1b (2020)	Horses can have up to 35 BD Prelim points, 0 points at Novice level or above. Horses cannot have competed at Novice level or above BD or BRC in the last 12 months.
<b>5: Senior Prelim</b>	E-Riders Prelim 2b (2020)	Horses can have unlimited BD Prelim Points, up to 35 Novice Points, 0 points at Elementary or above. Horses cannot have competed in Elementary or above BD or BRC in the last 12 months.
<b>4: Novice</b>	E-Riders Novice 3b (2020)	Horses can have unlimited Novice Points, up to 35 Elementary Points, 0 points at Medium or above.
<b>5: Elementary</b>	E-Riders Elementary 4b (2020)	Open eligibility
<b>6: Medium &amp; Advanced Medium (Pick A Test)</b>	E-Riders Medium 5a (2020) OR E-Riders Advanced Medium 6a (2020)	Open eligibility
<b>7: Bitless Bridle (Pick a Test)</b>	E-Riders Intro 1b (2020) <b>OR</b> E-Riders Prelim 2b (2020)	Open eligibility

### **Qualification to BRC NAF Five Star National Championships**

*Winning combinations in classes 2 – 6 (please see above) will receive an invite to compete in a relevant class at the BRC National Championship (5-6 September 2026) to compete in a similar test as to be confirmed at BRC's discretion. No wildcards or pass downs of invites will be given. Combinations who qualify for the championships will be required to follow BRC dress & tack rules at the Championships. Teams will not receive an invite to the championships (individuals only). **Competitors wishing to qualify for the National Championships MUST have a Competition Pass***

***with the name of the horse they are competing on listed before the close on entries.***

**Rules:**

This competition is run under British Riding Clubs 2026 Handbook rules unless superseded by the rules below. The current BRC Handbook and Rule Amendments document can be found on: <https://www.bhs.org.uk/british-riding-clubs/brc-handbook/>

1. Any rider under 18 years of age must have permission from a parent or guardian.
2. All competitors must be current BRC members to take part, *exceptions may apply at the discretion of BRC.*
3. Riders who have competed at BRC dressage qualifiers, must ride for the same club as they did at qualifiers
4. Horses must be aged 4yrs and over.
5. Refunds are via E-Riders only, when entering a class, you agree to abide by their terms & conditions.
6. Once you have uploaded your video or link you may not delete or re-upload a new video. If you have made a mistake, please email [susie@e-riders.co.uk](mailto:susie@e-riders.co.uk) asap.
7. **You must verbally introduce your video with your name, horses name, class and riding club name. Failure to do so may result in a 2-point deduction.**
8. E-Riders and BRC will share details of entries as required to fulfil the competition requirements, this will also include Sponsors.

**Tack & Turnout:**

9. **Riding hats** and **suitable footwear** with a heel must be worn. Gloves are optional.
10. **Spurs are only permitted for Prelim level and above.**
11. No nosebands required.
12. Smart dress is required.
13. Horses may wear boots/ bandages, and any bit is permitted.
14. Bitless bridles are only permitted in the specified bitless bridle class and must be a true bitless bridle, for example a head collar with reins attached is not a 'bitless bridle'.
15. Double bridles are only permitted for Elementary level and above.
16. Side saddles are permitted at all levels.
17. All saddlery and equipment are to be correctly fitted, used as intended in its manufactured state without adaptations and must be available for general purchase.
