BHS Stage 3 / BHSQ Level 3

Mapping your achievements to the BHS career pathways from September 2020

All qualifications should undergo a regular review period to ensure they remain fit for purpose. Vocational qualifications, such as the BHS qualifications, need to evolve with the industry to ensure that relevant and current skills and knowledge are assessed so those that gain the qualification are prepared for employment.

The BHS is proud of our world-class, industry leading qualifications developed for the modern equestrian industry. BHS qualifications are awarded by <u>British Horse Society Qualifications</u> (BHSQ). BHSQ is an awarding organisation recognised and regulated by the Office of the Qualifications and Examinations Regulator (Ofqual) in England, SQA Accreditation in Scotland, Qualifications Wales (QW) and the Council for the Curriculum, Examinations and Assessment (CCEA) in Northern Ireland.

As we have updated our qualifications, we have put measures in place to support learners that have started, but not yet completed, their Stage 3 qualification. Or, they have completed qualifications before May 2020 and would like to achieve a BHSQ Groom, Groom with Riding or Coach qualification. There may be additional 'top up' of skills or knowledge that is required for a learner to be awarded a BHSQ qualification. This ensures that learners who are awarded a Stage 3 BHSQ qualification have the skills and knowledge reflected in the current syllabus providing clarity for learners and employers.

For further information on any of the current BHSQ Level 3 (Stage 3) units, please refer to our website.

The process detailed below is required if a learner wants to achieve a BHSQ Level 3 (Stage 3) qualification. The processes below are not required if a learner wants to progress to the next level/Stage, they have already been awarded the BHSQ qualification, or have not yet started or achieved any part (section or unit) of a qualification listed below.

1. How to achieve the BHSQ Level 3 Coach in Complete Horsemanship (Stage 3) if you have achieved some qualifications or awards before 1 May 2020

The BHSQ Level 3 Coach in Complete Horsemanship (Stage 3) qualification is awarded upon achievement of a Stage 3 Care, Lunge, Ride (Dressage, Jump or both) and Coaching element. If you have already achieved, in full, any of the Care, Lunge and Ride elements (you have been awarded a unit or qualification certificate) and not yet achieved the Coaching unit, you will be required to evidence currency of your (Care, Lunge and Ride) skills and knowledge. This will be in addition to completing the Coaching unit (<u>Unit 5: Stage 3 Coaching</u>) to be awarded the BHSQ Level 3 Coach in Complete Horsemanship (Stage 3). The evidence you will provide is determined by when you achieved your Care, Lunge and Ride elements. References of currency are required if you achieved your qualification 10 or more years ago; this is to show your knowledge and skills remain current as the industry has evolved over time. If you have achieved your qualification within the last 10 years and want to transition to a BHSQ qualification, the evidence you will need to supply will be determined by which qualification you achieved.



1.1 If you have achieved your Stage 3 Care and/or Ride 10 or more years ago.

If you completed any of the above awards 10 or more years ago and are still yet to complete the Coaching element, you will be required to submit a BHS Assessor reference to confirm currency of your skills and achieve Unit 5: Stage 3 Coaching to be awarded the BHSQ Level 3 Coach in Complete Horsemanship (Stage 3).

The reference must be completed by a BHS Assessor and they must complete the Assessor Reference Template; this ensures a breadth of evidence is supplied. Your reference should be submitted to BHS and will be reviewed by BHSQ. The BHS Assessor can be someone you know or work with but should not be a family member. The assessor can review your skills and knowledge via methods such as professional discussion, observation, video review or live stream video. However, the assessor must complete the Assessor Reference Template upon review of the evidence. The assessor may charge for this service. If you do not know a BHS Assessor please contact the Education Team who can provide contact details. Once you have selected an assessor please ask them to contact the Education Team to confirm they will be providing a reference.

Your reference and completion of the online worming module is **not required** to be submitted to be able to enter or achieve the Stage 3 Coaching unit or to progress to any Stage 4 assessments. These are only required if you want to be awarded the BHSQ Level 3 Coach in Complete Horsemanship (Stage 3). Your reference should be submitted within 12 months of achieving Unit 5: Stage 3 Coaching. If you do not submit a reference or complete the online worming module, you can still complete Unit 5: Stage 3 Coaching, but you will not be awarded a BHSQ Level 3 Coach qualification. You will be able to progress to Stage 4 assessments.



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1.2 If you have achieved your Care and/or Ride awarded by EQL less than 10 years ago and before September 2017

The Stage 3 was awarded by EQL between 2011-September 2017. If you achieved your EQL qualification 10 or more years ago, please see Table 1 for guidance. Table 2 provides guidance if you achieved your EQL qualification less than 10 years ago.

If you have achieved the EQL Level 3 Diploma in BHS Riding Horses and have not completed the Coaching unit, you will be required to complete the Skills Record for Stage 3 Ride Dressage and Stage 3 Ride Jump, to include Ready for Assessments. If you have achieved the EQL Level 3 Diploma in BHS Horse Knowledge and Care and have not completed the Coaching unit, you will be required to complete the Skills Record for Stage 3 Care and Stage 3 Lunge, to include Coach Endorsements and Ready for Assessments, and complete the BHS online worming module. In addition you will be assessed on the assessment criteria listed in the table

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above, these will be assessed on your coaching assessment day. You will complete Unit 5: Stage 3 Coaching, to be awarded the BHSQ Level 3 Coach in Complete Horsemanship (Stage 3). The additional evidence required reflects currency of skills and knowledge and are required to be signed off if you would like to achieve the Level 3 Coach qualification.

The Skills Record can be completed by any BHS Accredited Professional who holds a minimum of the Stage 4 Senior Care. Your completed Skills Record should be submitted to BHS.

Your Skills Record, completion of the online worming module and completion of the additional assessment criteria are not required to be able to enter or achieve the Stage 3 Coaching unit, to progress to any Stage 4 assessments, or to join the BHS's Accredited Professional membership. Skills Records, assessment of additional criteria and completion of the online worming module are only required if you want to be awarded the BHSQ Level 3 Coach in Complete Horsemanship (Stage 3). Your Skills Record should be submitted and the online worming module completed within 12 months of achieving Unit 5: Stage 3 Coaching. If you do not submit the coach endorsement or complete the online worming module you can still complete Unit 5: Stage 3 Coaching and you will be issued with a unit letter of achievement. You will not be awarded a BHSQ Level 3 Coach qualification but you will be able to progress to Stage 4 assessments and join the Accredited Professional Coach membership.

1.3 If you achieved your Stage 3 Care, Ride and/or Teach between September 2017 – April 2020

If within this time period you completed the EQL/BHSQ Level 3 Diploma in BHS Horse Knowledge and Care and/or the EQL Level 3 Diploma in BHS Riding Horses please refer to table 2.

If you started and completed your Stage 3 ride between September 2017 and April 2020 there are no requirements for you to complete extra assessments or provide extra evidence. The section you hold maps directly to the new BHSQ units.

If you started and completed your Stage 3 care between September 2017 and April 2020, you will need to be assessed on assessment criteria 1.4 Explain employment rights. This can be assessed on your coaching assessment day. You will complete Unit 5: Stage 3 Coaching, to be awarded the BHSQ Level 3 Coach in Complete Horsemanship (Stage 3). The additional evidence required reflects the skills that were not part of the syllabus at the time, but are included within the BHSQ Level 3 Coach in Complete Horsemanship (Stage 3), so are required to be signed off if you would like to achieve the Level 3 Coach qualification.

Your assessment of the additional assessment criteria (1.4) is not required to be able to enter or achieve the Stage 3 Coaching unit, to progress to any Stage 4 assessments, or to join the BHS's Accredited Professional membership. Assessment of additional criteria is only required if you want to be awarded the BHSQ Level 3 Coach in Complete Horsemanship (Stage 3). If you choose not to be assessed on assessment criteria 1.4, you can still complete Unit 5: Stage 3 Coaching and you will be issued with a unit letter of achievement. You will not be awarded a BHSQ Level 3 Coach qualification but you will be able to progress to Stage 4 assessments and join the Accredited Professional Coach membership.

If you started and completed your Stage 3 teach between September 2017 and April 2020 there are no requirements for you to complete extra assessments or provide extra evidence. The section you hold maps to the new BHSQ Stage 3 Teach unit. You do however have the option to apply to receive the BHSQ Level 3 Coaching Riders (Stage 3) qualification. You will be required to submit a reference from a BHS Assessor to confirm currency of skills and knowledge against the current BHSQ Unit 5: Stage 3 Coaching syllabus (**Appendix 4**). In addition, you will be required to pay a fee to cover your registration for the qualification.

2. If you started a unit, but have not completed

If you have taken a Stage 3 assessment within the last 10 years, but have not achieved the full qualification, we are able to support you to complete the relevant learning outcomes to achieve the current BHSQ unit. If you have taken a Stage 3 assessment 10 or more years ago but did not achieve a qualification it is recommended that you take the new Stage 3 unit in its entirety.



All assessments taken from September 2017 will require a completion of a <u>Skills Record</u>. You will be required to have your Skills Record signed if transitioning to the BHS Career Pathways and taking an assessment. Please refer to the relevant table below.

2.1. If you are part way through your Stage 3 Care, Lunge and or Ride (started less than 10 years ago and before September 2017)

This will be assessed on your assessment day.

Upon completion of your required learning outcomes, you will be issued with a BHSQ unit letter of achievement and any applicable BHSQ qualification certificate.

3. If you have achieved your Preliminary Teaching Test and completed the coaching portfolio

The window for submission of a coaching portfolio or coaching logbook towards the BHSAI has now expired. The BHSAI is no longer being awarded. If you want to achieve the BHSQ Level 3 Coach in Complete Horsemanship as the alternative you are required to complete BHSQ Unit 5: Stage 3 Coaching as the current alternative. If you had submitted a coaching portfolio or logbook, and this was validated by us, we are pleased to be able to offer a 50% discount on the assessment fee for BHSQ Unit 5: Stage 3 Coaching.

If you have already achieved the Care, Lunge and Ride elements, please follow the guidance within this document for details on how to be awarded the BHSQ Level 3 Coach in Complete Horsemanship.

If you have completed the PTT and portfolio or logbook you can progress to Stage 4 coaching assessments, if you have also completed Stage 3 Care, Lunge and Ride sections you can apply to join the BHS's Accredited Professional membership. Unit 5: Stage 3 Coaching is only required if you want to be awarded the BHSQ Level 3 Coach in Complete Horsemanship (Stage 3).
