5. From SCRA (Scottish Children's Reporter), 2019-20, how many children and young people in Scotland were referred to the Reporter on non-offence (Care and Protection) grounds?

- 4,567
- 12,849
- 6,321

**Answer - 12,849** children and young people in Scotland were referred to the Reporter:

- 10,823 on non-offence (care and protection) grounds;
- 2,840 on offence grounds.

6. How many Child Protection Orders were granted to address emergency and/or high risk situations where measures need to be put in place immediately to protect a child or young person – SCRA (Scottish Children's Reporter), 2019-20

- 547
- 379
- 987

7. In Scotland, what was the most common ground for referral, as recorded by the SCRA, Scottish Children's Reporter, 2019-20?

- Offence committed against a child
- Close connection with person who has carried out domestic abuse
- Child's conduct harmful to self or others
