BRC Rule Changes June 2025

Rule Changes with Immediate Effect:

1. Gloves are no longer compulsory for riding in dressage competitions.

Future Rule Changes

- **2. Jump-off heights:** When running under option 1 or 2 from the Handbook, jump-off heights to be capped at the same height as the 2^{nd} round (so will not go up any higher than 5cm above the class height).
- Change from summer show jumping championship classes at the BRC National Champs held at Lincoln.
- **3. The BRC Dressage tests** will be renamed, changing the number to a letter, to make them more distinguishable from the BD tests e.g. BRC Prelim 1, will become BRC Prelim A and so on.
- Change for the start of the Winter Qualifiers 2025.
- **4. Class name changes:** The previous named Introductory, Novice & Intermediate Classes will be renamed as below:

Grassroots Dressage (formerly Introductory Dressage) Intermediate Dressage (formerly Novice Dressage) Open Dressage (formerly Intermediate Dressage)

- Change for the start of the Winter Qualifiers 2025.
- **5. Change the Summer Dressage to the same classes as the Winter Dressage:** With the same eligibility and tests. (Only difference would be the Intro Pairs in winter and the Pairs in summer. DTM to stay as it is in winter.)
- Change for Summer Qualifiers 2026
