Rules and Regulations

This competition will run under British Riding Club Rules. Entries

Entries are by invitation only to those that have qualified. They will be sent to the team manager from the qualifier with instructions on how to process them. Please note entries close on **12 August 2022**.

Times

Times will be posted on our website www.britishridingclubs.org.uk approximately one week before the championships. Times are selected randomly by computer, and cannot be altered. Please note that competitors should be ready to jump before their time in case the competition runs early. Please check with the collecting ring steward on the day.

Flu Vaccination Certificates

All competing horses and ponies must have an up-to-date full flu vaccination certificate and comply with BRC rules. If your flu vaccination does not comply, or you do not bring the complete record with you, you will be eliminated. Details of how flu vacs will be checked will be on the competitor information document published with the times.

A flu vac checker is also available to download from the downloads section of the BRC website.

Hats & Body Protectors

Hats meeting the current standards must be always worn and securely fastened when mounted. It is also advised to wear a hat when handling on the ground. Body Protectors can be worn at riders' discretion. Up to date standards can be found in the BRC Handbook or on the website.

Competitors riding in an Exo-Body cage must inform the Secretary at least 30 minutes before their start time.

Refund Policy

Abandonment insurance is in place for this championship. Please see the National Championships page on the BRC website for full details on when a refund may be due in the event of abandonment.

Failure to decline a championship invitation before the close of entry so it can be passed down the line may result in the club being charged the entry fee.

During the championships

Declarations and Secretary's

Upon arrival, head to the declarations/stable managers marquee. Details for arriving on site including flu vacs will be published in the competitor information document along with the times on the website.

All other queries including scoring can be dealt with by the secretary.

Accessibility

Visitors with mobility restrictions, who would usually use motorised vehicles, should contact the secretary's office for information and assistance regarding accessibility at this event.

Parking

Please follow the direction of the car parking attendants.

Presentations

Presentations will be approximately 30 minutes after final results have been posted depending on space in the presentation ring. Delays to the presentation will be as a result of objections or queries that will need to be resolved before it can go ahead. Attendance for the presentation will be as per the programme. 1st- 3rd individual and team presentations will be mounted. 4th-10th placing to collect their rosettes from secretary's.

Salvers

Salvers awarded at championships must be signed for by a nominated person who is then responsible for that salver. It must be returned to arrive at the office on the date stated on the form by recorded delivery and must be packaged with care. Any loss/damage or failure to return the trophy by the specified date will result in the club concerned being invoiced for the cost of a replacement. BRC may also refer such matters to the BRC Discipline Committee.

Official Objections

Protests or complaints may be lodged in writing and accompanied by a deposit of £20. They must be addressed to the Official Steward via the secretary. Protests must be made no later than 30 minutes after the incident that gave rise to that protest or up until 30 minutes after the final results have been published. The deposit will be forfeited unless the protest is upheld or it was decided that there were good and reasonable grounds for lodging the protest.

Official Photographs

Please be advised that filming and/or photography will be taking place during the BRC Championships - this could be in the arenas, seating areas, stabling and lorry park during competition hours. If you do not wish to appear in any images captured please inform the secretary so that we can take appropriate steps to ensure you are not included. The photographs/film could potentially be included in British Riding Clubs publications or in BRC promotional materials in the future and may also be published on the BRC section of the BHS website. They could also be passed onto the sponsor of the event and the press.

Dogs

Dogs are permitted on the showground, however they must be kept under control on a short lead at all times and cleared up after. ID tags must be worn.

Smoking Policy

There is a strict no smoking policy in the stabling area and in the main arenas onsite.

Exercising Horses

Please see competitor information document published with the times. Competitor numbers/bridle numbers/bib numbers must be worn when mounted. Strictly no entry into competition arenas unless competing, doing so will result in disqualification from the competition. There will be no arena walk at this Championships.

Catering

Catering will be available on site.

Toilets

Strictly no emptying of lorry waste (Eslan) in the toilets.

Medical Care

Paramedics will be on site during the competition hours of the championships. Outside of these hours, in an emergency please dial 999.

Vet and Farrier

We will have a vet and farrier on site for this event during competition hours and an on call vet for outside competition hours. Please contact an official on the day for contact details.

Horse Ambulance

A horse ambulance will be present on site during the competition hours of the weekend.

Belongings

BRC are not responsible for competitors belongings, please ensure you lock away any valuables safely.

General information

The whole event will be run on grass. Except Ring 1A warm up which is partially surfaced.

Accommodation

There are a number of hotels in the surrounding area, please find more information online. Camping will be available in designated areas with toilets and showers available on site.
