

## **BHS Guidance on Judges and Officials for Equestrian Events**

---

There are set judges and officials necessary for equestrian events, below is a summary of the requirements, if you have any further queries you can contact your local Development Team member or the relevant discipline for advice.

### **Dressage**

Dressage judge from the appropriate BD/DI Panel List per arena

- Preliminary and Novice List 1 to 5
- Elementary and Pairs List 1 to 5
- Medium List 1 to 3
- DTM and pairs DTM List 1 to 5
- Horse Trials List 1 to 5

\*If a list five or above judge cannot be found a list six may be used if appropriate.

- One writer per judge
- One steward per arena or per two arenas
- Tack Steward
- Chief Scorer
- Scorers (several depending on the number of arenas being run)
- Scoreboard Writer
- Score Sheet Co-ordinator
- Score Sheet Collectors (one for every two arenas)

### **Show and Style Jumping**

- Show jumping judge from the current BS or SJAI Judges Panel
- Time judge
- Writer
- Course builder, preferably from the current BS/SJAI Course Builders Panel
- Collecting Ring Steward
- Tack Steward
- Commentator
- Arena party

### **Cross-country**

- Course builder
- Chief Cross-country Steward
- Cross-Country Control (two people)
- Collecting Ring Steward
- Tack Steward
- Cross-Country Starter
- Time Keepers for both start and finish
- Fence Judges, preferably two per fence
- Commentator
- Fence Repair Team
- Refreshment Steward
- Chief Scorer
