Important Information

- Please send your music over digital by midday on Wednesday 29 September (e.g. windows media player) to brcentries@bhs.org.uk with your competitor number and class. After this time, you will need to bring your music by CD. Please also have a back-up available on the day.
- If you are showing any symptoms of Covid-19 do not attend. Stay at home.
- Ensure you have a mask to bring.
- Do not attend if you or any member of your household has been told to self-isolate.

Before leaving home

- Please print your own numbers: Bib numbers (front and back), back numbers, bridle and/or saddlecloth numbers (on both sides of the horse) are all permitted. Numbers will be published with times.
- Print/write your number to display in your lorry/car window at the event.

Upon Arrival

- Display your competitor number in the front window of your vehicle. Our car parking team will be on the driveway to direct you, please follow their directions. If you arrive late and they have finished for the day – please make yourself known to them the next day.
- Flu vaccinations will be checked as you enter the site, stable details will also be given here.
- Bring your flu vac compliant voucher to declarations which will be in the main building. Please ensure your Flu vacs are up to date, a flu vaccination checker can be found available on the BRC Downloads page on the website. - Hat tagging can be done at declarations – Quadrille competitors must bring their hat even if it is tagged to be checked to ensure it complies with BRC rules on costumes.
- There will be no Quadrille competitor briefing this year.
- If you have not sent your music digitally, please hand in to the secretary upon arrival and mark with your competitor number and class. If you have submitted digitally please bring a back-up just in case.

On site considerations

- No dogs in the main building, they are permitted in the lorry park and must be on a short lead at all times.
- Check back here next week for café opening times.
- Showers and toilets are at the back of the warm-up indoor arenas. Toilets can also be found next in the main building but these are locked at night.
- There is a tack shop on site at Bury Farm Equestrian.

- Horse&Country TV will be live streaming the championship classes and you can purchase your test from them.
- Equi-Dance will be on site and may ask to interview you after your test.
- A vet and paramedic will be on site during competition hours. There is no designated farrier available, we will do our best to help you find a farrier through local contacts if required.

Exercising

- Outside of competition hours there will be no first aid or veterinary cover on site, if you require emergency first aid please call 999 and inform the secretary as soon as possible.
- Strictly no lunging.

- Arena walk times are on the timetable, competitors are permitted around the outside of the arena on a loose rein, competitors must follow the direction of the steward and go in the

same direction, then change rein when requested. Quadrille arena walk times are for Quadrille competitors only on the Quadrille times document.

Music

- Music to be sent digitally before competition by midday on Wednesday 29 September. Music submitted after this time will not be accepted as we will not be able to transfer onto the laptop. Any music after this time must be brought with you. The baskets will be in the main building next to the stairs. Please bring your CD's in an envelope clearly marked with your name, competitor number and any special considerations (such as music also being used for novice test). USB sticks can be used but CD's are preferable as we will need to switch systems to use the USB sticks so may cause a slight delay.
- If your music fails, carry on unless the judge rings the bell indicating you to stop. They will then discuss with you how they would like you to continue.

Results, Presentations and Score Sheets

- There will be score boards at the event.
- Scores will be posted on the new scoring website <https://brscores.bhs.org.uk> periodically throughout the event and will be published in full on the BRC website after the event.
- Score sheets will be available after the class has finished, collected from the Secretary area.
- Presentations for Championship classes will be mounted 1st – 3rd in the main arena. Please see timetable for provisional times. Direct entry classes will be collected from the Secretary.
- Winners of championship classes will need to report to the Secretary to collect your salver. Prizes in kind will be posted out by TopSpec after the event.
