



## Important Competitor Information

### Flu Vacs and declarations

Flu Vacs – You will enter the site into the field area where you will be directed by the car parking team to the flu vac team. They will be located in the corner of the car park. You will need to have your passports ready in the lorry to pass to the flu vac checkers, who will check your vaccinations before you park and unload. Once confirmed the flu vaccinations are correct you will be given a flu vac laminate. You will then be directed to park. Please allow time to go through these checks before parking. The flu vac team will be in place from 0700 on Saturday and Sunday mornings. Please do not park or unload your horse before being checked. If the car parking team send you to the hard standing car park due to overflow please liaise with the car parking team to radio the Secretary to arrange your flu vac checks before unloading your horse. If your horse fails the flu vac check, you will not be able to unload the horse and will be asked to leave site immediately.

In order to declare and collect your number you will need to take your flu vac laminate to declarations. You can, if you wish to and have helpers with you, bring your horse with you down the horse walk tacked up ready to go, but under no circumstances are you to mount without your competitor number. If you are alone it would be best to give yourself plenty of time to get declared and go back to your horse.

The hard standing car park will be for officials and cars only; however, in the event of very wet weather we may change this plan accordingly.

### General information

- Secretary's and Declarations can be found in the Log Cabin by the main arena

- Course Walks – please be aware there are no gaps once the class has started to walk the course so course walks will only be open at the start of each class (please refer to the timetable for start times)

- Please read rules on falls from page 33 of the Handbook
- There will be two competitors on course at the same time, so please listen to the sounds for the SJ and XC arenas as they will be different. Check with the collecting ring steward if you are unsure
- There will be catering on site in the form of a burger and a crepe van
- Trade stands will be located next to the Log Cabin
- There will be antibacterial gel available at various locations around the site so please help yourselves
