Consultation on the draft Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2015

Response of The British Horse Society

Reference is made to the proposed 'route for use by ...' signs as set out in diagrams 956.1 and 956.2. These are two alternative signs - 956.1 which indicates a right of way for pedestrians, pedal cycles, and ridden horses, and 956.2 which indicates a right of way for pedestrians, pedal cycles, and horse-drawn vehicles, but **not ridden** horses as well.

The Society considers that this must be a mistake, and diagram 956.2 **should** include ridden horses.
