



BHS Gloucestershire Guided Pleasure Ride Terms and Conditions

General

- Advance bookings are classed as those made or received before 6pm on Friday 11 September 2020.
- Strictly no refunds, except if the event is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances.
- All riders must hold third party public liability insurance either through being a Gold member of The British Horse Society or via proof from another provider.
- Please report to the organisers on arrival and follow the instructions of the organizer/guides at all times.
- Hi viz must be worn.
- All riders are responsible for ensuring the safety of themselves and others.
- All riders must have previous experience of riding the horse they are bringing to the ride.
- Always ride with courtesy, care and consideration to fellow riders and others you may meet on the route including equestrians, cyclists, walkers, particularly those who may be elderly, disabled, children, or simply be frightened of horses. Ride slowly past others.
- Do not stray from the guided route.
- Leave gates as you find them and ride slowly past any livestock.

Riders

- Riders under 16 years must be accompanied by a responsible adult for the duration of the event.
- Riders over 16 and under 18 may ride unaccompanied at the discretion of their parent or guardian.
- Hats to the current standard must be worn and correctly secured at all times when mounted. Please check yours meets current standards which can be found at <http://www.bhs.org.uk/headwear>
- Body protectors are strongly recommended and should comply with current standards – also found on the BHS website at <http://www.bhs.org.uk/body-protectors>
- All riders must wear suitable riding footwear. Wellington boots and trainers are not allowed.
- Riders are advised to carry a mobile phone.
- Bring your own water buckets and water to the event.

Horses

- All horses must be no younger than four years of age and be of an appropriate fitness level for the activity being undertaken – hooves and shoes must be in good condition.
- Tack must be suitable, in safe condition and fit correctly.
- No stallions.
- All horses must be up to date with annual equine influenza vaccinations.
- Horses should not be left unattended if tied to horseboxes.
- It is a legal requirement to have your horses' passport when travelling to events.

Covid -19

- We will be adhering to Government Advice relating to Covid-19 as it stands on the date of the event.
- Any specific instructions relating to Covid-19 compliance will be emailed to all participants in advance of the event.
