Rules and Regulations

This competition will run under British Riding Club rules. Entries

Entries are by invitation only to those that have qualified. Invites are uploaded to the clubs Sport80 account and can be viewed by the clubs registered committee members.

Entries can only be made through the Sport80 platform.

Please note entries strictly close at 5pm on Thursday 12th September 2024.

Combined Training

Combined Training consists of one dressage test and one course of show jumps. Both individuals and teams can qualify for this competition.

Senior teams; two team members will ride a prelim dressage test and show jump at 70cm. The other two members will ride a novice dressage test and show jumping at 80cm.

Junior teams; two team members will ride a prelim dressage test and show jump at 70cm, one rider will ride a prelim dressage test and show jump at 80cm and the final member will ride a novice dressage test and show jumping at 80cm.

The winning team will be decided from the best three scores in both phases.

Elimination from one phase will result in elimination from the other.

For the seniors there will also be additional individual sections where riders compete at Novice dressage/70cm SJ and Prelim dressage/80cm SJ.

Combined Challenge

The Combined challenge is a test of the ability and timing of a horse and rider to negotiate a show jumping course followed by a cross-county course on grass. The classes will be as below: 70cm Junior for teams & individuals 80cm Junior for teams & individuals

70cm Senior for teams & individuals 80cm Senior for teams & individuals

90cm Mixed class (senior and/or juniors) for teams & individuals 100cm Mixed class (senior and/or juniors) for teams & individuals

Times

Times will be posted on our website approximately one week before the championships. Times are selected randomly by computer and cannot be altered. There will be important competitor information released with the times, which must be read before leaving for the competition. Please note that competitors should be ready to jump before their time in case the competition runs early. Please check with the collecting ring steward on the day.

Stabling

For stabling information and to book go to: https://brc.bhs.org.uk/select Price is £55.00 per night. Additional costs may occur for late bookings.

There will be no hook up available at this event.

Flu Vaccination

All competing horses and ponies must have an up-to-date full flu vaccination certificate and comply with BRC rules. If your flu vaccination does not comply, or you do not bring the complete record with you, you will be eliminated.

Please note if your horse has restarted, that the time between the initial 3 vaccinations has been altered starting from 1st January 2024. The new time between initial vaccinations can be found in the BRC Handbook 2024.

Hats & Body Protectors

Hats meeting the current standards must always be worn and securely fastened when mounted. It is also advised to wear a hat when handling on the ground.

Body Protectors are mandatory for the Combined Challenge and optional for the Combined Training. Up to date standards must be worn where mandatory and can be found in the BRC Handbook or on the website.

Refund Policy

Failure to decline a championship invitation before the close of entry so it can be passed down the line may result in the club being charged the entry fee. The refund policy can be found in the BRC Handbook.

During the championships

<u>Upon arrival ALL competitors must declare at the Declarations marque; failure to do so will result in elimination</u>. You will need to bring your horses passport and body protector with you to be checked. Hats can also be tagged at this time.

All other queries at the event including scoring can be dealt with by the secretary.

Parking

Please follow the direction of the car parking attendants. Please note that due to space and numbers, it may not be possible to leave space for other team members/mates to park next to each other. **If you want to park near each other, you will need to coordinate to arrive at the same time.**

Presentations

Presentations will be approximately 30 minutes after the final results of each class have been posted. Please check the scores website https://www.ridingclubresults.co.uk/ for the time of presentations. Delays to the presentation will be because of objections or queries that will need to be resolved before it can go ahead.

Attendance requirements for the presentation will be posted in the WhatsApp community.

Salvers

Salvers awarded at championships must be signed for by a nominated person who is then responsible for that salver. It must be returned engraved to arrive at the office on the date stated on the form by recorded delivery and must be packaged with care.

Any loss/damage or failure to return the salver by the specified date will result in the club concerned being invoiced for the cost of a replacement. BRC may also refer such matters to the BRC Discipline Committee.

If a salver is returned without being engraved the club or competitor will be charged the cost to do so.

Official Objections

Protests or complaints may be lodged in writing and accompanied by a deposit of £20. They must be addressed to the Official Steward via the secretary. Protests must be made no later than 30 minutes after the incident that gave rise to that protest or 30 minutes after the results have been published. The deposit will be forfeited unless the protest is upheld, or it was decided that there were good and reasonable grounds for lodging the protest.

Please be advised that filming and/or photography will be taking place during the BRC Championships - this could be in the arenas, seating areas, stabling and lorry park during competition hours. The photographs/film could potentially be included in BRC publications or in BRC promotional materials in the future and may also be published on the

BRC section of the BHS website. They could also be passed onto the sponsor of the event and the press.

Exercising Horses

Please see the Important Competitor Information document which will be published alongside the times for information. Competitor numbers must always be worn when mounted. Strictly no entry into competition arenas unless competing.

Catering

Catering will be available on site during the event, approximate opening timings can be found in the Important Competitor Information document published with the times.

Medical Care

Paramedics will be on site during the competition hours of the championships. Outside of these hours, in an emergency please dial 999.

Vet and Farrier

We will have a vet and farrier on site for this event during competition hours. There will be an on-call vet for outside competition hours. Please contact an official on the day for contact details.

Horse Ambulance

A horse ambulance will be present on site during the competition hours of the weekend.

Dogs

Dogs are permitted on the showground; however, they must always be kept under control on a short lead and cleared up after. ID tags must be worn. Please adhere to notices of restriction for dogs.

Do not leave dogs in cars or lorries if it is too hot to do so!

Toilets

Strictly no emptying of lorry waste (Eslan) in the toilets.

Smoking Policy

There is a strict no smoking policy in the main areas onsite.

Belongings

BRC are not responsible for competitors belongings, please ensure you lock away any valuables safely.

Accommodation

There are several hotels in the surrounding area, please find more information online. Camping will be available in designated areas.

Trade Stands

A list of trade stands attending the championships will be published in the programme available online before the event.

Merchandise
